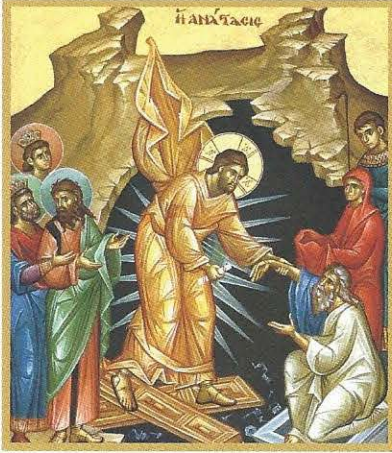


Christ is Risen!

St. Nicholas Church is proud to invite you this year to a Pascha like no other. After absence, after darkened windows and locked doors for months, after the ravages of a pandemic that crippled our city, we are glad to be able to welcome you back home. On Palm Sunday, when we celebrate Jesus' own triumphal entry into the holy city of Jerusalem, the front doors of our Church will be unlocked for the first time in thirteen months as we mark our own moment of victory also. Please plan to be present.

The schedule for our Holy Week and Pashka services is below. Pick some days for prayer and come. And when you come, we are relying on you to help us keep the doors open—we need you to be ready both to celebrate with joy and to follow directions. On Palm Sunday, Good Friday, and Holy Pascha, ushers will meet you at the door; follow them in and listen. Have your mask handy as you get ready for Church and be prepared for things to be a little bit different than in years past. The candles, the fire, the sounds and smells and friends you know are waiting for you here—no reservations needed. St. Nicholas Church welcomes all its children home!
